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Agenda for 67th Session of Council

Public Meeting - Community Improvement Plans (CIP) - Following a Statutory Public Meeting, Council adopted an Industrial Community Improvement Plan and a Brownfield Community Improvement Plan. The purpose of the two Community Improvement Plans is to assist in the revitalization and encourage investment or reinvestment in Loyalist Township.

Taxi Commission and Ride Share Regulation Harmonization Update

Council directed staff to work with City of Kingston staff to assist in their preparation of a further report with information on options to incorporate the licensing, regulating, and governing of the owners and drivers of taxi cabs within municipal services and oversight.

Love Road Speed Limit Petition

Council received a report in response to a petition that was previously submitted to Council. Council advised staff to notify the residents of Love Road that the Road does not currently meet the criteria in the Traffic Calming Policy; and that when the Traffic Calming Policy is reviewed as part of the Township's Infrastructure Master Plan, there is a component allowing for exceptions to be made to the Policy.

Funding Options for Purchase of Gowan Property

At the November 22, 2021 Regular Council Meeting. Council agreed to purchase the Gowan property on Amherst Island for the purchase amount of \$350,324.35, plus legal and survey costs of \$7,399.01. At the June 13, 2022 meeting, Council directed staff to fund the purchase of property from the General Rate Capital Reserve Fund.

NRK Development Limited - Draft Plan of Subdivision

Council approved applications for Draft Plan of Subdivision, Official Plan amendment and Zoning Bylaw amendment related to a proposed subdivision in Part of Lot 35, Concession 4, and addressed 315 Main Street, Odessa.

Delegations - Adrian Jacklin regarding Community Centre and Library in Odessa

Council received a presentation regarding the need for a Community Centre and Library in Odessa. Council directed staff to prepare a staff report presenting possible options for a Community Centre in Odessa.

Delegations - Jake Ennis regarding Gun Road improvements

Council received a presentation on behalf of Gun Road property owners expressing interest in having Gun Road improved to Township standards such that the Township would then assume Gun Road. Council directed staff to prepare a report identifying the feasibility and financial impact of this request.
