
Loyalist Township collects property taxes in order to provide local services such as road repair, snow removal, fire services, recreational facilities and more. This only represents 54% of the property taxes you pay. Loyalist Township also collects property taxes on behalf of the County of Lennox And Addington and the Province of Ontario (Education). Assessment Growth helped reduce the tax rate by 4.7%.

Treasurer's Statement:

Loyalist Township is in a difficult transition stage as we wait for assessment revenues from growth to catch up with the demand for services from that same growth. The future looks bright, however, cuts to new projects, programs and services were necessary in the 2024 budget in order to offset the increase in non-discretionary costs. The adopted budget holds the line on expenditures, as much as possible. Capital projects that have been identified as necessary in the asset management plan are moving forward. Several projects have been pushed out to future years to reduce costs in 2024, however, this is not a sustainable funding model. A longrange financial plan is being prepared to identify major projects which will need to be funded over the long term and the impact of the revenues from the future new assessment.

General Rate Capital Budget

The Capital Budget represents significant expenditures that generate a benefit beyond one year. These include the acquisition, replacement, and betterment of capital infrastructure/assets such as roads, buildings, and vehicles. The 2024 Capital Budget is funded through sizeable grants, reserves, taxation debt, and fundraising.
