Presentations and Delegations

Statutory Public Meeting

Council approved the <u>Zoning By-law Amendment Applications - Emma Street</u> to rezone the lands to address a number of site-specific performance standards to help facilitate the creation of eight single-detached lots.

<u>Fields of Loyalist - Creekford Developments - Draft Plan of Subdivision Official Plan Amendment and</u> <u>Zoning By-Law Amendment</u> The proposed subdivision consists of 194 single detached dwellings and 390 semi-detached dwelling units, and two medium density blocks consisting of 103 units for a total of 687 residential units, two parkland blocks, multi-use pathways connecting the development with Main Street and expansion of the existing Odessa West stormwater management facility. A recommendation will be brought forward to Council once the comments from the Township departments, agencies and the public have been addressed.

Items for Consideration

- Congratulations to two post-secondary students who have each been awarded \$1,000 from the <u>2024 Ameriks Scholarship</u>. Both recipients have lived on Amherst Island for a minimum of five years.
- Council supported the concurrence and installation of a proposed <u>Telecommunication Tower</u> facility at 925 Stella Forty-Foot Road, Amherst Island, by Xplore Inc. The tower will provide fiber services to the community. A statement of concurrence is required by ISED, the final approval authority for telecommunication towers.

Committee of the Whole

• Staff provided an overview of the <u>Draft Capacity Allocation Policy</u>. The proposed policy establishes a framework for the allocation and revocation of water and sanitary sewage servicing capacity, through the Township's planning application review and approval process.
