Delegations

Tracy Chalifoux, Municipal and Utility Access Relations Specialist at Xplore Inc. provided information about the rollout of the Amherst Island project via <u>PowerPoint presentation</u>.

Items for Consideration

Council made the following decisions:

- Approved the <u>Additional Budget Request Odessa West Reconstruction Project</u> and Emma Street Servicing Allowance of \$265,000 from the General Capital Reserve (as available) with the balance to be funded from new debt financing and up to \$215,000 from Water Rate reserve and \$55,000 from Sewer Rate reserve.
- Directed staff to engage a consultant to complete a <u>Fleet Condition and Needs Study</u> and the project be funded up to \$25,000 from the Fleet and Equipment Reserve Fund.
- Approved the implementation of <u>fees for the Heritage</u>, <u>Culture and Tourism Division's</u> attractions, events and services, as considered in the 2025 operating budget. The current Miscellaneous Fees and Charges By-law 2022-006 was amended to include these new fees.
- Council approved the use of the <u>Housing Accelerator Fund Round 2 (HAF 2)</u> to fund critical path items including recruitment of staff to support the program and retention of consultants.
